The European Medicines Research Training Network (EMTRAIN) is a network within the Innovative Medicines Initiative (IMI) focusing on European education and training covering the whole life cycle of medicines research, from basic science through clinical development to pharmacovigilance.

An important part of the EMTRAIN work is to organise the EMTRAIN PhD workshop. The workshop is a forum for PhD students enrolled in a Public-Private Partnership (PPP) programme to share experience, network and grow into their role as industry-aware scientist. The programme includes scientific lectures, interactive seminars, oral presentations from the students and round table discussions with the faculty. Previous workshops have received high praise and 96% of previous participants say they have increased their knowledge of the drug industry and 100% would recommend the workshop to a friend.

PhD students We are now accepting applications from students to attend the 2014 PhD workshop. We accept applications from PhD students enrolled in a PPP and whose supervisors actively support their participation in the workshop. For a limited number of positions we also accept applications from PhD students not enrolled in a PPP, but with a strong motivation to enter into pharma industry in the future. For student that does not receive financial support for travel and accommodation from their supervisors there are a limited number of EMTRAIN scholarships offered.

Industry PhD supervisors We invite you to nominate PhD students or young post-doctoral researchers who you think would benefit from attending the PhD workshop. We accept nominations of PhD students enrolled in a PPP and young postdocs with experience from a PPP. The nomination of a participant implies that you commit to sponsor the cost for travel and accommodation for the student. This needs to be indicated in the application form. EMTRAIN partners can claim this cost as in-kind contribution.
